On Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2025 Athy Triathlon Club will host our annual Junior Flat Out Duathlon events in Narraghmore from 9am.



The series of races, which span junior participants non ages + to 19 years old, are run in conjunction with Triathlon Ireland and this year a number of our races have been selected as part of the Duathlon Youth National Series. This year our races also double up as the National Primary and Post Primary Schools Championships for 2025, with school team prizes on offer. We expect to have athletes of all abilities participating, from those competing to gain points in the Youth National Series and Schools Championships, to beginners taking part in their first event for fun.

The duathlon event incorporates both run and cycle elements in each race. 
